You are invited to submit an abstract for oral or poster presentation. The Vitamin D Workshop is the most important meeting, solely dedicated to vitamin D.

Delft is a medieval city with a historic city centre, beautiful monuments and canals. It is the city of the Prince of Orange in the 16th century, and the 17th century painter Johannes Vermeer and the microscopist Antoni van Leeuwenhoek. The Delft Blue majolica originates from this city. The meeting is in the spring, the season of the tulips and other flowering bulbs. The Vitamin D Workshop is organized just before the joint meeting of the European Calcified Tissue Society and the International Bone and Mineral Society in Rotterdam, April 25-28 in 2015.
